Colorful Soap Making

Hello artful friends, we'll explore three easy ways to add vibrant colors to your melt-and-pour soap, using liquid soap dyes, edible food colorants, and mica powders to create colored pieces of soap.



INGREDIENTS

Supplies Needed

- Liquid soap dye
- Edible food coloring
- Mica powders
- Spray bottle with ethanol alcohol
- Melt and pour soap base

Liquid Soap Dyes

- Let's start with melted liquid soap
- Next, add a few drops of soap dye and stir thoroughly till the desired color
- Tip: Start with just a little bit and build up the color as needed

Edible Food Coloring

- Next, we'll explore using edible food coloring.
- Add a few drops to your melted soap to combine.
- Tip: Food coloring can produce beautiful, vibrant shades

INGREDIENTS

Mica Powders

- Finally, let's talk about using mica powders
- Take a small amount of mica and mix it into a smooth paste.

Tip : Micas will create a stunning, lustrous effect in the final bars
