INGREDIENTS

- First up, we have the 2 types of melt- and-pour soap bases. This is the foundation for our soaps - it's a pre-made soap that you can simply melt down and then customize however you like.
- Next, we've got an all-purpose silicone mold. These are perfect for shaping our soaps into simple yet creative designs. The silicone makes it super easy to pop the soaps out once they're hardened
- To stir and mix everything, we have these handy wooden stirrers with paper cups to manage portions and mixing.

INGREDIENTS

- For adding color, we have 2 mica powders and 2 soap dyes. Just a little bit of these will give our soaps a beautiful, vibrant hue
- To add natural soap texture and bring out the natural beauty of the soap, we can add these beautiful dried decorants to accentuate the overall presentation of the soap
- And to make our soaps smell amazing, we have this bottle of fragrance oil. You can use as much or as little as you'd like to get the perfect scent.
- Let's not forget the alcohol spray bottle. This will help us get a smooth, blemish-free-looking finish on our soaps.
